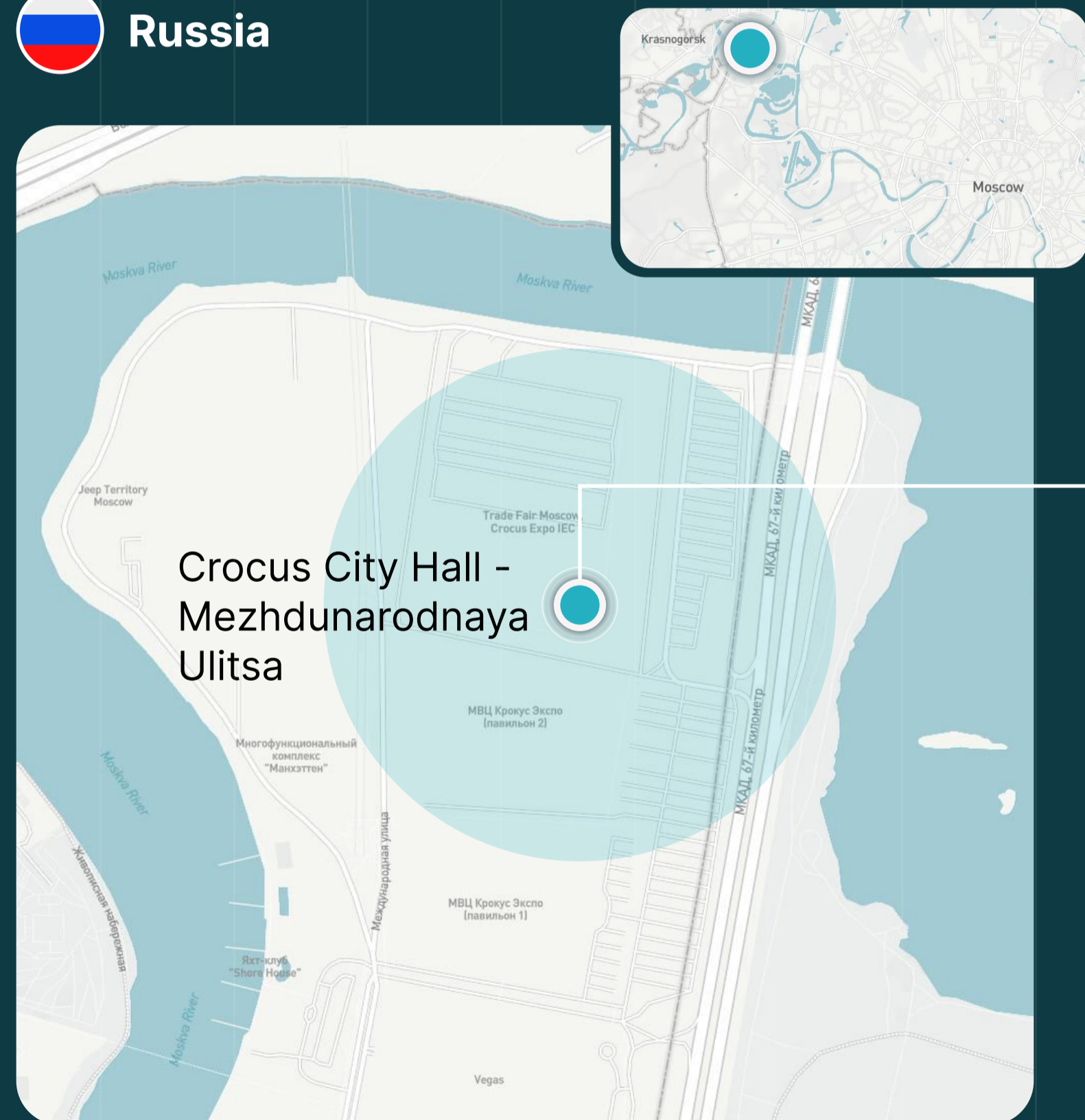

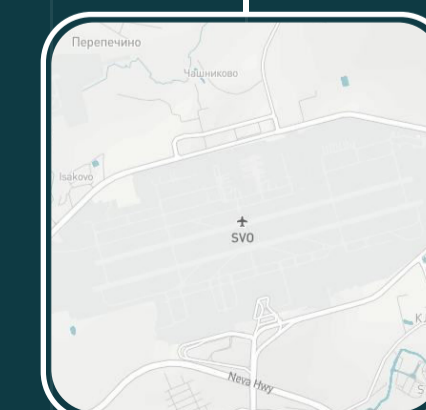

Event summary

## Crocus City Hall attack

On 22 March 2024 at around 17:00 GMT, four armed men burst into the Crocus City Hall in Krasnogorsk, Moscow oblast, Russia, and carried out a mass shooting and stabbing attack, before using incendiary devices to set fire to the venue. The attack led to the cancellation of public events, the closure of shopping centres and cultural venues across the country, and the implementation of additional security measures at airports and transport hubs in the Moscow oblast for several days.

The Islamic State Khorasan Province (ISKP) claimed responsibility for the attack, which killed 145 people and injured more than 500 others. In the days following the attack, a series of bomb threats were issued at airports, including Moscow's Sheremetyevo airport, disrupting flight operations.
